1. The work carried out at the Teton Repair Café is performed free of charge on a voluntary basis by the repair experts at hand.
2. Visitors offering broken items for repair do so at their own risk.
3. Visitors carry out the repairs themselves whenever possible with repair experts helping as necessary.
4. A voluntary donation is greatly appreciated.
5. The fact that the repairs are being performed by unpaid volunteers reflects the allocation of risks and limitation of liability: neither the organizers of the Teton Repair Café nor the repair experts are liable for any loss that may result from advice or instructions concerning repairs, for the loss of items handed over for repair, for indirect or consequential loss or for any other kind of loss resulting from work performed in the Teton Repair Café.
6. Experts making repairs offer no guarantee for the repairs carried out with their help and are not liable if objects repaired at the Teton Repair Café do not to work properly at home.
7. Repair experts are entitled to refuse to repair items and are not obliged to reassemble disassembled appliances that cannot be repaired.
8. Visitors to the Teton Repair Café are solely responsible for the removal of all items from the event venue and for properly disposing of any parts or broken items.
9. Neither the organizers of the Teton Repair Café nor the repair volunteers are liable for any loss resulting from advice or instructions concerning repairs, for the loss of items handed over for repair, for consequential loss, or for any other kind of loss resulting from work performed in the Repair Café.
10. Safety of items repaired off-site is not the responsibility of the Teton Repair Café.
11. By signing this form, you are confirming that you consent to the Teton Repair Café holding and processing your personal data for the purpose of keeping you informed of news, events, and activities related to the Repair Café.
12. To reduce unnecessary waiting times during busy periods, a maximum of ONE broken item per person will be examined. The visitor will join the back of the queue if there is a second item for repair to ensure that as many people get help as possible.
