CoChallengers are a special group of individuals and businesses who donate matching funds to Old Bill's. CoChallengers do not designate their gifts for specific nonprofits, and instead provide the matching grants that participating nonprofits receive. Led by Mr. and Mrs. Old Bill, who donate \$500,000 or more annually, CoChallengers give at levels ranging from \$25,000-\$500,000. Timed Runners: If you want to be timed, you must register by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 6.

Bib Pickup: Timed runner bibs can be picked up at the Community Foundation (245 E. Simpson Ave.) from September 2–5, between 9 a.m.–5 p.m., or on Run Day at Jackson Elementary School Field from 7:30–8:30 a.m.

Win and Give Back: The top three finishers in each category will receive prize money to donate to their favorite Old Bill's nonprofits.

Timed Run Categories:
Adaptive 5K and 10K, Adult 5K and 10K
Youth 5K and 10K

Only walkers, runners, strollers, mobility devices, and approved guides using equipment to assist adaptive athletes are allowed on the course. For safety reasons, all other wheeled devices—such as bicycles and skateboards—are not permitted.

Dogs that are well-behaved in crowds are welcome. They must be kept on a short leash and picked up after.

When: Saturday, September 6, 2025
Nonprofit booths open at 8:30 a.m.
Adaptive Timed Run starts at 8:50 a.m.
Adult 5K & 10K, Youth 5K & 10K, and Walkers start at 9 a.m.
Where: Old Bill's Fun Run starts and finishes at the Jackson Elementary School Field on Willow Street. The route travels through East Jackson, into the National Elk Refuge, and down Broadway. (Visit oldbills.org for a detailed route map.)

What: Before and after the run, explore 100+ booths in the Nonprofit Village to learn about local nonprofits and celebrate community philanthropy.
