IT'S EASY (AND FREE!) TO SIGN UP:

1. Register to run or walk at oldbills.org.
2. Registration is free! Advance registration is encouraged.
3. Runners who wish to be timed must register by Friday, September 8th at 5:00pm.
4. Timed runner bibs are available for pickup at the Community Foundation (245 E. Simpson Ave.) on September 5-8 from 9am-5pm; or at Jackson Elementary School Field on Run Day, September 9 from 8am-9am.
5. On Run Day, the start gun fires at 9am sharp.
6. The top three male and female adult and youth runners in the timed 5K and 10K win cash to donate to their favorite participating nonprofits.

For safety, bicycles, skateboards, roller skates, and other wheeled transportation are prohibited. Only walkers, runners, strollers, and wheelchairs are allowed.

Dogs that are well-behaved in crowds are welcome. They must be kept on a short leash and picked up after.

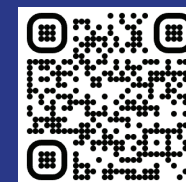
IMPORTANT RUN DAY INFORMATION
