Our grantmaking strives to make meaningful impact and promote a culture of philanthropy. The Foundation employs two granting channels to achieve these complementary goals.

# Impact Investing

Through our impact investing program, **Invest Jackson**, the Community Foundation connects philanthropic capital with local nonprofits that need affordable financing.



## INVEST JACKSON

### OVERARCHING GOALS:

Invest Jackson is a new program designed to help nonprofits in Teton County, WY access mission-critical capital more easily and at a lower cost. The program works in partnership with local and regional banks to provide flexible, practical financing tailored to real needs, whether bridging funding gaps, refinancing existing debt, or supporting growth.

Investments are expected to be repaid and will require full due diligence and intermediary pairing.

### TARGET INVESTMENT PARAMETERS

**SIZE:** \$50K - \$250K

**INTEREST:** 2-4%

**TERM:** 2-7 years

**REQUIREMENTS:** Specified need for capital and defined repayment sources
